AN ACT TO PREVENT THE USE OF MOTORCYCLES AND ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLES THAT HAVE ENGINE SIZES THAT ARE FIFTY CUBIC CENTIMETERS OR LESS FROM PARTICIPATING IN ANY EVENT WITH MOTORCYCLES OR ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLES THAT HAVE ENGINE SIZES THAT ARE GREATER THAN FIFTY CUBIC CENTIMETERS.

15 16 **SECTION 1.** Chapter 20 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new section to read:

"§ 20-146.1A. Operation of small engine motorcycles or all-terrain vehicles.

It is unlawful for any person, firm, or corporation to operate, or allow the operation of, any motorcycle or all-terrain vehicle that has an engine size of 50 cubic centimeters or less in any event with motorcycles or all-terrain vehicles that have engine sizes greater than 50 cubic centimeters. A violation of this section is a Class 3 misdemeanor."

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective December 1, 2007, and applies to offenses committed on or after that date.
