A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO PREVENT THE USE OF MOTORCYCLES AND ALL-TERRAIN  
2 VEHICLES THAT HAVE ENGINE SIZES THAT ARE FIFTY CUBIC  
3 CENTIMETERS OR LESS FROM PARTICIPATING IN ANY EVENT WITH  
4 MOTORCYCLES OR ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLES THAT HAVE ENGINE SIZES  
5 THAT ARE GREATER THAN FIFTY CUBIC CENTIMETERS.

7 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

8 **SECTION 1.** Chapter 20 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a  
9 new section to read:

10 "**§ 20-146.1A. Operation of small engine motorcycles or all-terrain vehicles.**

11 It is unlawful for any person, firm, or corporation to operate, or allow the operation  
12 of, any motorcycle or all-terrain vehicle that has an engine size of 50 cubic centimeters  
13 or less in any event with motorcycles or all-terrain vehicles that have engine sizes  
14 greater than 50 cubic centimeters. A violation of this section is a Class 3 misdemeanor."

15 **SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective December 1, 2007, and applies to  
16 offenses committed on or after that date.
