of, any motorcycle or all-terrain vehicle that has an engine size of 50 cubic c	entimeters
or less in any organized racing or organized practice event with moto	rcycles or
all-terrain vehicles that have engine sizes greater than 50 cubic centimeters. A	A violation
of this section is a Class 3 misdemeanor."	
SECTION 2. This act becomes effective December 1, 2007, and	applies to
offenses committed on or after that date.	_
