| 11 | SECTION 1. G.S. 15A-401(b)(2) reads as rewritten: |
| 12 | "(2) Offense Out of Presence of Officer. – An officer may arrest without a |
| 13 | warrant any person who the officer has probable cause to believe: |
| 14 | a. Has committed a felony; or |
| 15 | b. Has committed a misdemeanor, and: |
| 16 | 1. Will not be apprehended unless immediately arrested, or |
| 17 | 2. May cause physical injury to himself or others, or |
| 18 | damage to property unless immediately arrested; or |
| 19 | c. Has committed a misdemeanor under G.S. 14-72.1, 14-134.3, |
| 20 | 20-138.1, or 20-138.2; or |
| 21 | d. Has committed a misdemeanor under G.S. 14-33(a), |
| 22 | 14-33(c)(1), $14-33(c)(2)$, or $14-34$ when the offense was |
