| 20     | <b>SECTION 3.</b> Expiration of Committee. – The Committee shall terminate on           |  |
| 21     | April 15, 2008, or upon the filing of its final report, whichever occurs first.         |  |
| 22     | <b>SECTION 4.</b> There is appropriated from the General Fund to the General            |  |
| 23     | Assembly the sum of fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) for the 2007-2008 fiscal year for |  |
| 24     | the costs of the Joint Study Committee on Military and Veterans Affairs created by this |  |
| 25     | act.  |  |
| 26     | <b>SECTION 5.</b> This act becomes effective July 1, 2007.                              |  |
