April 19, 2007 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT EXEMPTING CERTAIN LOCKSMITHS FROM CONTINUING EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS UNDER THE LOCKSMITH LICENSING ACT. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: **SECTION 1.** Chapter 74F of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new section to read: "§ 74F-10.1. Continuing education requirements exemptions. The following persons shall be exempt from continuing education requirements established by the Board: A locksmith issued a license under this Chapter who is in active (1) practice as a locksmith and has at least 20 consecutive years of experience as a locksmith. A locksmith issued a license under this Chapter who is 60 years of age (2) or older and has at least 10 consecutive years of experience as a locksmith." **SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
