The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:	
<b>SECTION 1.</b> G.S. 20-63(b) reads as rewritten:	
"§ 20-63. Registration plates furnished by Division; requirements; rep	placement of
regular plates with First in Flight plates: surrender and	L

12 (b) Every license plate shall have displayed upon it the registration number 13 assigned to the vehicle for which it is issued, the name of the State of North Carolina, 14 which may be abbreviated, and the year number for which it is issued or the date of 15 expiration. A plate issued for a commercial vehicle, as defined in G.S. 20-4.2(1), and weighing 26,001 pounds or more, must bear the word "commercial," unless the plate is 16 a special registration plate authorized in G.S. 20-79.4 or the commercial vehicle is a 17 18 trailer or is licensed for 6,000 pounds or less. The plate issued for vehicles licensed for 7,000 pounds through 26,000 pounds must bear the word "weighted". 19

20 Except as otherwise provided in this subsection, a registration plate issued by the 21 Division for a private passenger vehicle or for a private hauler vehicle licensed for 22 6,000 pounds or less shall be a "First in Flight" plate. A "First in Flight" plate shall have 23 the words "First in Flight" printed at the top of the plate above all other letters and 24 numerals. The background of the plate shall depict the Wright Brothers biplane flying 25 over Kitty Hawk Beach, with the plane flying slightly upward and to the right. The following special registration plates do not have to be a "First in Flight" plate. The 26 design of the plates that are not "First in Flight" plates must be approved by the Division 27 and the State Highway Patrol for clarity and ease of identification. 28

24 "(b) Distribution of Fees. – The Special Registration Plate Account and the 25 Collegiate and Cultural Attraction Plate Account are established within the Highway 26 Fund. The Division must credit the additional fee imposed for the special registration 27 plates listed in subsection (a) among the Special Registration Plate Account (SRPA), the 28 Collegiate and Cultural Attraction Plate Account (CCAPA), the Natural Heritage Trust 29 Fund (NHTF), which is established under G.S. 113-77.7, and the Parks and Recreation 30 Trust Fund, which is established under G.S. 113-44.15, as follows:
