The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
SECTION 1. Article 8 of Chapter 14

18 19 **SECTION 1.** Article 8 of Chapter 14 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new section to read:

"§ 14-33.3. Battery on a law enforcement officer, probation or parole officer, or on a person employed at a State or local detention facility.

Unless the conduct is covered under some other provision of law providing greater punishment, it is a Class H felony for anyone to commit a battery on a person described by this section while the person is discharging or attempting to discharge his or her official duties:

- (1) A law enforcement officer.
- (2) A probation or parole officer.
- 16 (3) A person who is employed at a detention facility operated under the jurisdiction of the State or a local government."

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective December 1, 2007, and applies to offenses committed on or after that date.
