HOUSE BILL 1905

Short Title: Funding the Visitors Center in Rocky Mount. (Public)

Sponsors: Representatives Bryant and Farmer-Butterfield (Primary Sponsors).

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT TO PROVIDE RECURRING FUNDING TO THE VISITORS CENTER IN
ROCKY MOUNT LOCATED ON U.S. HIGHWAY 64 AT INTERSTATE 95.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. G.S. 20-79.7(c)(2) reads as rewritten:

"(2) From the funds remaining in the Special Registration Plate Account after the deductions in accordance with subdivision (1) of this subsection, there is annually appropriated from the Special Registration Plate Account the sum of one million one hundred thousand dollars ~~(\$1,000,000)~~—(\$1,100,000) to provide operating assistance for the Visitor Centers:

- a. on U.S. Highway 17 in Camden County, (\$100,000);
- b. on U.S. Highway 17 in Brunswick County, (\$100,000);
- c. on U.S. Highway 441 in Macon County, (\$100,000);
- d. in the Town of Boone, Watauga County, (\$100,000);
- e. on U.S. Highway 29 in Caswell County, (\$100,000);
- f. on U.S. Highway 70 in Carteret County, (\$100,000);
- g. on U.S. Highway 64 in Tyrrell County, (\$100,000);
- h. at the intersection of U.S. Highway 701 and N.C. 904 in Columbus County, (\$100,000);
- i. on U.S. Highway 221 in McDowell County, (\$100,000); ~~and~~
- j. on Staton Road in Transylvania County, ~~(\$100,000)~~—(\$100,000); and
- k. on U.S. Highway 64 at Interstate 95 in Rocky Mount, (\$100,000)."

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2007.
