AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO RECRUIT EXCELLENT TEACHERS TO AT-RISK SCHOOLS.

SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Public Instruction the sum of one million seven hundred thousand dollars (\$1,700,000) for the 2007-2008 fiscal year and the sum of one million seven hundred thousand dollars (\$1,700,000) for the 2008-2009 fiscal year. The State Board of Education shall use these funds to establish signing bonuses for excellent teachers who teach at schools at which a high percentage of the students are at risk of academic failure.

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2007.
