4	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:		
5		SECTION 1. G.S. 20-79.4(b) is amended by adding a new subdivision to

7	"(b)	Types The Division shall issue the following types of special registration	
8	plates:

10		(1a) Active Duty Military. – Issuable to a member of the armed forces of	
11		the United States who presents documentation to the Division, for an	
12		initial application and renewal, that the member is still serving on	
13		active duty. The plate shall bear the name and insignia of the	
14		appropriate service branch. Plates shall be numbered sequentially for	
15		members of a branch with the numbers 1 through 5,000 reserved for	
16		officers, without regard to rank.

18		SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2008.
