A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT DIRECTING THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC INSTRUCTION TO
DEVELOP AND IMPLEMENT APPROPRIATE GRADE-LEVEL
CURRICULUM MATERIALS ON THE 1898 WILMINGTON RACE RIOT.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. Article 8 of Chapter 115C of the General Statutes is amended
by adding a new section to read:

§ 115C-81.3. Curriculum on 1898 Wilmington Race Riot.

The State Board of Education shall develop and implement curriculum learning
experiences on the 1898 Wilmington Race Riot, developing appropriate grade-level
curriculum materials, and provide teacher workshops for effectively integrating the
materials into instruction."

SECTION 2. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the
Department of Public Instruction the sum of one hundred ninety-nine thousand dollars
(\$199,000) for the 2008-2009 fiscal year to implement the provisions of this act.

SECTION 3. This act becomes effective July 1, 2008.
