A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR PUBLIC AWARENESS CAMPAIGNS
AND COMMUNICATIONS STRATEGIES ON STROKE SIGNS AND
SYMPTOMS, AS RECOMMENDED BY THE JUSTUS-WARREN HEART
DISEASE AND STROKE PREVENTION TASK FORCE.

**SECTION 1.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Public Health, the sum of three hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$350,000) for the 2008-2009 fiscal year. These funds shall be used to develop and implement public awareness campaigns and communications strategies on signs and symptoms of stroke.

**SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2008.
