A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO CONTINUE THE JOINT LEGISLATIVE COMMISSION ON PREVENTION AND HIGH SCHOOL DROPOUT GRADUATION, AS RECOMMENDED BY THE JOINT LEGISLATIVE COMMISSION ON DROPOUT PREVENTION AND HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATION.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

**SECTION 1.** Section 7.32 (f)(8) of S.L. 2007-323 reads as rewritten:

8 The Commission may submit an interim report, including any "(8)9 recommendations and proposed legislation, to the Joint Legislative 10 Education Oversight Committee and the General Assembly by May 1, 11 2008, and shall submit a final an interim written report of its findings and recommendations on or before the convening of the 2009 Session 12 of the General Assembly. The Commission may submit an interim 13 report, including any recommendations and proposed legislation, to the 14 Joint Legislative Education Oversight Committee and the General 15 Assembly by May 1, 2010, and shall submit a final written report of its 16 findings and recommendations on or before the convening of the 2011 17 Session of the General Assembly. All reports shall be filed with the 18 President Pro Tempore of the Senate, the Speaker of the House of 19 Representatives, and the Legislative Librarian. Upon filing its final 20 21 report, the Commission shall terminate." 22

**SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
