A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO INCREASE SUPPORT FOR TUTORING AND MENTORING PROGRAMS IN NEW HANOVER AND PENDER COUNTIES TARGETING AT-RISK YOUTH AS RECOMMENDED BY THE 1898 WILMINGTON RACE RIOT COMMISSION.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

 SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the New Hanover County Schools the sum of one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) for the 2008-2009 fiscal year. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Pender County Schools the sum of one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) for the 2008-2009 fiscal year. Each system shall use these funds to implement a program in conjunction with community-based organizations to increase support for tutoring and mentoring programs that target at-risk youth in the county.

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2008.
