Assembly of North Carolina enacts: ECTION 1. G.S. 90-113.74(c) is amended by adding a new subdivision to the Department shall release data in the controlled substances reporting the following persons only:
(<u>8</u>	A sheriff whose office is involved in an investigation of diversion and illegal use of prescription medication or a deputy sheriff whose primary duties involve the investigation of diversion and illegal use of prescription medication and who is engaged in a bona fide specific investigation related to enforcement of laws governing licit drugs. The sheriff shall notify the Office of the Attorney General of North Carolina of each request for inspection of records maintained by the Department."

SECTION 2. This act applies only to Moore County.
SECTION 3. This act becomes effective October 1, 2008.
