3	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
4	<b>SECTION 1.</b> G.S. 143-299.2 reads as rewritten:
5	"§ 143-299.2. Limitation on payments by the State.
6	(a) The maximum amount that the State may pay cumulatively to all claimants
7	on account of injury and damage to any one person arising out of any one occurrence,
8	whether the claim or claims are brought under this Article, or Article 31A or Article
9	31B of this Chapter, shall be five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000), one million
10	dollars (\$1,000,000), less any commercial liability insurance purchased by the State and
11	applicable to the claim or claims under G.S. 143-291(b), 143-300.6(c), or
12	143-300.16(c).
13	(b) The fact that a claim or claims may be brought under more than one Article
14	under this Chapter shall not increase the above maximum liability of the State."
15	<b>SECTION 2.</b> This act applies with respect to torts committed on or after the

16 date this act becomes law.
