2	AN ACT TO PERMIT THE CITY OF OXFORD TO LEVY A MOTOR VEHICLE
3	PRIVILEGE TAX OF UP TO TWENTY DOLLARS FOR EACH RESIDENT
4	VEHICLE LOCATED IN THE TOWN.
5	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
6	SECTION 1. G.S. 20-97(a), as rewritten by Section 1 of Chapter 610 of the
7	1987 Session Laws, reads as rewritten:
8	"(a) All taxes levied under the provisions of this Article are intended as
9	compensatory taxes for the use and privileges of the public highways of this State, and
10	shall be paid by the Commissioner to the State Treasurer, to be credited by him to the
11	State Highway Fund; and no county or municipality shall levy any license or privilege
12	tax upon any motor vehicle licensed by the State of North Carolina, except that cities
13	and towns other than the City of Durham may levy not more than ten dollars
14	(\$10.00) <u>twenty dollars (\$20.00)</u> per year upon any vehicle resident therein, and except
15	that the City of Durham may levy not more than one dollar (\$1.00) per year upon any
16	vehicle resident therein. Provided, further, that cities and towns may levy, in addition to
17	the amounts hereinabove provided for, a sum not to exceed fifteen dollars (\$15.00) per
18	year upon each vehicle operated in such city or town as a taxicab."
19	SECTION 2. This act applies to the City of Oxford only.
20	SECTION 3. This act is effective upon ratification.
