The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:	
SECTION 1. G.S. 115C-5 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:	
	ne State Board of Community Colleges may retain and budget fees charged
to students taking the General Education Development (GED) test. Fees collected for	
this purpose shall be used only to (i) offset the cost of the GED test, including the cost	
of scoring the test, (ii) offset the course of printing GED certificates, and (iii) meet	
federal and State reporting requirements related to the test."	
SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2008.
