A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO CLARIFY THAT BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS IN HYDE COUNTY

HOLDING MEETINGS BY CONFERENCE TELEPHONE OR OTHER

ELECTRONIC MEANS MAY ADOPT PROCEDURES FOR MEMBERS

VOTING REMOTELY.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. G.S. 143-318.10(d) defines "official meetings" to include a meeting with simultaneous communication by conference telephone or other electronic means of a majority of members for the purpose of voting upon or otherwise transacting the public business, while G.S. 143-318.13(a) provides for public access to such communication under the Open Meetings Law.

SECTION 2. A public body may adopt rules of procedure governing members voting and deliberating in a meeting with simultaneous communication by conference telephone or other electronic means.

SECTION 3. This act applies to Hyde County only.

SECTION 4. This act is effective when it becomes law.
