5	SECTION 1. G.S. 143-318.12(b) reads as rewritten:				
6	"(b) If a p	bublic body holds an official meeting at any time or place other than a			
7	time or place sh	nown on the schedule filed pursuant to subsection (a) of this section, it			
8	shall give public notice of the time and place of that meeting as provided in this				
9	subsection.				
10	(1)	If a public body recesses a regular, special, or emergency meeting held			
11		pursuant to public notice given in compliance with this subsection, and			
12		the time and place at which the meeting is to be continued is			
13		announced in open session, no further notice shall be required.			
14	(2)	For any other meeting, except an emergency meeting, the public body			
15		shall cause written notice of the meeting stating its purpose (i) to be			
16		posted on the principal bulletin board of the public body or, if the			
17		public body has no such bulletin board, at the door of its usual meeting			
18		room, (ii) if the public body has a Web site, to be posted there, and (ii)			
19		(iii) to be mailed_mailed, e-mailed, or delivered to each newspaper,			
20		wire service, radio station, and television station, which has filed a			
21		written request for notice with the clerk or secretary of the public body			
22		or with some other person designated by the public body. The public			
23		body shall also cause notice to be mailed mailed, e-mailed, or			
24		delivered to any person, in addition to the representatives of the media			
25		listed above, who has filed a written request with the clerk, secretary,			
26		or other person designated by the public body. This notice shall be			
27		posted and mailed or delivered at least 48 hours before the time of the

1		meeting. meeting, except if the only newspaper that has requested
2		notice publishes weekly, the notice shall be mailed or delivered at least
3		eight days before the time of the meeting. The public body may require
4		each newspaper, wire service, radio station, and television station
5		submitting a written request for notice to renew the request annually.
6		The public body shall charge a fee to persons other than the media,
7		who request notice, of ten dollars (\$10.00) per calendar year, and may
8		require them to renew their requests quarterly. No fee shall be charged
9		for notices sent by e-mail.
10	(3)	For an emergency meeting, the public body shall cause notice of the
11		meeting stating its purpose (i) to be posted prior to the meeting on the
12		principal bulletin board of the public body or, if the public body has no
13		such bulletin board, at the door of its usual meeting room, unless a
14		disaster has made it impossible to post such notices and the meeting is
15		not being held in the building where meetings are usually held, (ii) to
16		be given prior to the meeting to each local newspaper, local wire
17		service, local radio station, and local television station that has filed a
18		written request, which includes the newspaper's, wire service's, or
19		station's <u>e-mail address or telephone number</u> , for emergency notice
20		with the clerk or secretary of the public body or with some other
21		person designated by the public body. body; (iii) if the public body has
22		a Web site, to be posted there prior to the meeting unless a disaster has
23		made that impossible, and (iv) if the public body has e-mail and if any
24		person has provided an e-mail address and requested notice of
25		meetings of the board, to be given prior to the meeting to such person
26		by e-mail unless a disaster has made it impossible to send e-mail. This
27		notice The notice under subdivision (ii) shall be given either by e-mail,
28		telephone telephone, or by the same method used to notify the
29		members of the public body and shall be given immediately after
30		notice has been given to those members. This notice shall be given at
31		the expense of the party notified. An "emergency meeting" is one
32		called because of generally unexpected circumstances that require
33		immediate consideration by the public body. Only business connected
34		with the emergency may be considered at a meeting to which notice is
35		given pursuant to this paragraph."
