A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO ELIMINATE THE POSTRETIREMENT EARNINGS RESTRICTION ON RETIREES UNDER THE TEACHERS' AND STATE EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT SYSTEM AND ENABLE RETIRED STATE EMPLOYEES TO RETURN TO WORK AFTER SIX MONTHS WITHOUT LOSING RETIREMENT BENEFITS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. G.S. 135-3(8)c. is repealed.

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2007.
