SECTION 1. G.S. 115C-321(a) is amended by adding three in	new subsections

a personnel file that is relevant to possible criminal misconduct may be	made available
to law enforcement and the district attorney to assist in the investigation	of:
(1) A report made to law enforcement pursuant to G.S. 115	(C-288(g), or
(2) Any report to law enforcement regarding an arson, a	ttempted arson,
destruction of, theft from, theft of, embezzlement from	, embezzlement
of any personal or real property owned by the local boa	rd of education.
(a2) The employee shall be given five working days prior writte	
disclosure under subsection (a1) of this section to permit the employee
