The Deputy President Pro Tempore of the Senate 3 shall be paid an annual salary of twenty-one thousand seven hundred thirty-nine dollars 4 (\$21,739) payable monthly, and an expense allowance of eight hundred thirty-six dollars (\$836.00) per month. The majority and minority leaders in the House and the 5 6 majority and minority leaders in the Senate shall be paid an annual salary of seventeen 7 thousand forty-eight dollars (\$17,048) payable monthly, and an expense allowance of 8 six hundred sixty-six dollars (\$666.00) per month. 9 (b) Every other member of the General Assembly shall receive increases in 10 annual salary only to the extent of and in the amounts equal to the average increases 11 received by employees of the State, effective upon convening of the next Regular 12 Session of the General Assembly after enactment of these increased amounts, except no 13 such increase is granted upon the convening of the 1997 Regular Session of the General 14 Assembly. Accordingly, upon convening of the 1997 Regular Session of the General 15 Assembly, every other member of the General Assembly shall be paid an annual salary 16 of thirteen thousand nine hundred fifty one dollars (\$13,951) payable monthly, and an 17 expense allowance of five hundred fifty nine dollars (\$559.00) per month. 18 The salary and expense allowances provided in this section are in addition to (c) 19 any per diem compensation and any subsistence and travel allowance authorized by any 20 other law with respect to any regular or extra session of the General Assembly, and 21 service on any State board, agency, commission, standing committee and study 22 commission." 23 **SECTION 2.** Effective upon convening of the 2009 Regular Session of the 24 General Assembly, G.S. 120-3.1(a)(3) reads as rewritten: 25 "(a) In addition to compensation for their services, members of the General 26 Assembly shall be paid the following allowances: 27 28 A subsistence allowance for meals and lodging at a daily rate equal to (3) 29 the maximum per diem rate for federal employees traveling to Raleigh, 30 North Carolina, as set out at 58 Federal Register 67959 (December 22, 31 1993), of one hundred thirty-four dollars (\$134.00) while the General 32 Assembly is in session and, except as otherwise provided in this 33 subdivision, while the General Assembly is not in session when, with 34 the approval of the Speaker of the House of Representatives in the case 35 of Representatives or the President Pro Tempore of the Senate in case 36 of Senators, the member is: 37 Traveling as a representative of the General Assembly or of its a. 38 committees or commissions, or 39 Otherwise in the service of the State. b. 40 A member who is authorized to travel, whether in or out of session, 41 within the United States outside North Carolina, may elect to receive, 42 in lieu of the amount provided in the preceding paragraph, a
