G.S. 106-568.3 reads as rewritten: 6 "§ 106-568.3. Action of Board of Agriculture on petition for referendum; creation 7 of the Tobacco Research Commission. The State Board of Agriculture, upon a petition being filed with it so 8 (a) 9 requesting and signed by the governing boards of the North Carolina Farm Bureau 10 Federation, the North Carolina State Grange, the North Carolina Agribusiness Council, 11 Inc., and the North Carolina Agricultural Foundation, Inc., shall examine such petition 12 and upon finding that it complies with the provisions of this Article shall authorize the 13 holding of a referendum as hereinafter set out and the governing boards of the North 14 Carolina Farm Bureau Federation, the North Carolina State Grange, the North Carolina 15 Agribusiness Council, Inc., and the North Carolina Agricultural Foundation, Inc., shall thereupon be fully authorized and empowered to hold and conduct on the part of the 16 17 producers and growers of the commodities herein mentioned a referendum on the 18 question of whether or not such growers and producers shall levy upon themselves an 19 assessment under and subject to and for the purposes stated in this Article. Provided, 20 that the petition for a tobacco referendum shall be signed by and, once approved, shall 21 authorize the holding of a referendum by the governing boards of the North Carolina 22 Farm Bureau Federation, Inc., the North Carolina State Grange, the North Carolina 23 Agribusiness Council, Inc., the North Carolina Tobacco Foundation, Inc., and the 24 Tobacco Growers Association of North Carolina, Incorporated. 25 There is hereby created a North Carolina Tobacco Research Commission (b)

(b) There is hereby created a North Carolina Tobacco Research Commission
within the Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services. The Commission shall
consist of the Commissioner of Agriculture, or his designee; the President of the North
Carolina Farm Bureau Federation, Inc., or his designee; the President of the Tobacco
Growers Association of North Carolina, Incorporated, or his designee; the Master of the
North Carolina State Grange, or his designee; the Executive Director of the North
<u>Carolina Agribusiness Council, Inc., or his designee</u>, and, the President of the North
Carolina Tobacco Foundation, Inc., or his designee."

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SECTION 3. G.S. 106-568.4 reads as rewritten:

34 "§ 106-568.4. By whom referendum to be managed; announcement.

35 The governing boards of the North Carolina Farm Bureau Federation, the North 36 Carolina State Grange, the North Carolina Agribusiness Council, Inc., and the North 37 Carolina Agricultural Foundation, Inc., shall arrange for and manage any referendum 38 conducted under the provisions of this Article but shall, 60 days before the date upon 39 which it is to be held, fix, determine, and publicly announce in each county the date, 40 hours, and polling places in that county for voting in such referendum, the amount and 41 basis proposed to be collected, the means by which such assessment shall be collected 42 as authorized by the growers and producers, and the general purposes for which said 43 funds so collected shall be applied. Provided, that the governing boards of the North Carolina Farm Bureau Federation, Inc., the North Carolina State Grange, the North 44

Carolina Agribusiness Council, Inc., the North Carolina Tobacco Foundation, Inc., and 1 2 the Tobacco Growers Association of North Carolina, Incorporated, shall arrange for and 3 manage any referendum for tobacco poundage assessments under the provisions of this 4 Article." 5 SECTION 4. G.S. 106-568.7 reads as rewritten: 6 "§ 106-568.7. Preparation and distribution of ballots; poll holders; canvass and 7 announcement of results. 8 The governing boards of the North Carolina Farm Bureau Federation, the North 9 Carolina State Grange, the North Carolina Agribusiness Council, Inc., and the North 10 Carolina Agricultural Foundation, Inc., shall prepare and distribute in advance of such 11 referendum all necessary ballots and shall under rules and regulations, adopted and 12 promulgated by the organizations holding such referendum, arrange for the necessary 13 poll holders and shall, within 10 days after the date of such referendum, canvass and 14 publicly declare the results thereof. Provided, that for the tobacco poundage assessment 15 referendum, the North Carolina Farm Bureau Federation, Inc., the North Carolina State Grange, the North Carolina Agribusiness Council, Inc., the North Carolina Tobacco 16 17 Foundation, Inc., and the Tobacco Growers Association of North Carolina, 18 Incorporated, shall perform the functions set forth in this section." 19 SECTION 5. G.S. 106-568.8(a) reads as rewritten: 20 Fertilizer and feed assessments. In the event two-thirds or more of the eligible "(a) 21 farmers and producers participating in said referendum vote in favor of such 22 assessment, then said assessment shall be collected for a period of six years under rules, 23 regulations, and methods as provided for in this Article. The assessments shall be added 24 to the wholesale purchase price of each ton of fertilizer, commercial feed, and/or their 25 ingredients (except lime and land plaster) by the manufacturer of said fertilizer and feed. 26 The assessment so collected shall be paid by the manufacturer into the hands of the 27 North Carolina Commissioner of Agriculture on the same tonnage and at the same time 28 and in the same manner as prescribed for the reporting of the inspection tax on 29 commercial feeds and fertilizers as prescribed by G.S. 106-284.40 and 106-671. The 30 Commissioner shall then remit the assessment for the total tonnage as reported by all 31 manufacturers of commercial feeds, fertilizers, and their ingredients to the treasurer of 32 the North Carolina Agricultural Foundation, Inc., who shall disburse such funds for the 33 purposes herein enumerated and not inconsistent with provisions contained in the 34 charter and bylaws of the North Carolina Agricultural Foundation, Inc. Signed copies of 35 the receipts for such remittances made by the Commissioner to the treasurer of the North Carolina Agricultural Foundation, Inc., shall be furnished the Commissioner of 36 37 Agriculture, the North Carolina Farm Bureau Federation, the North Carolina 38 Agribusiness Council, Inc., and the North Carolina State Grange. The treasurer of the 39 North Carolina Agricultural Foundation, Inc., shall make an annual report at each 40 annual meeting of the Foundation directors of total receipts and disbursements for the 41 year and shall file a copy of said report with the Commissioner of Agriculture and shall 42 make available a copy of said report for publication.

It shall be the duty of the Commissioner of Agriculture to audit and check the remittances of the assessment by the manufacturer to the Commissioner in the same

manner and at the same time as audits and checks are made of remittances of the 1 2 inspection tax on commercial feeds and fertilizers. 3 Any commercial feed excluded from the payment of the inspection fee required by 4 G.S. 106-284.40 shall nevertheless be subject to the assessment provided for by this 5 Article and to quarterly tonnage reports to the Department of Agriculture and Consumer 6 Services as provided for in G.S. 106-284.40(c)." 7 SECTION 6. G.S. 106-568.10 reads as rewritten: 8 "§ 106-568.10. Subsequent referenda; continuation of assessment. 9 If the assessment is defeated in the referendum, the governing boards of the North 10 Carolina Farm Bureau Federation, the North Carolina State Grange, the North Carolina 11 Agribusiness Council, Inc., and the North Carolina Agricultural Foundation, Inc., shall 12 have full power and authority to call another referendum for the purposes herein set out 13 in the next succeeding year on the question of the annual assessment for six years. In the 14 event the assessment carried in a referendum by two-thirds or more of the eligible 15 farmers participating therein, such assessment shall be levied annually for the six years set forth in the call for such referendum and a new referendum may be called and 16 17 conducted during the sixth year of such period on the question of whether or not such 18 assessment shall be continued for the next ensuing six years. Provided, that if the 19 tobacco poundage assessment is defeated in the referendum, the governing boards of the 20 North Carolina Farm Bureau Federation, Inc., the North Carolina State Grange, the 21 North Carolina Agribusiness Council, Inc., the North Carolina Tobacco Foundation, 22 Inc., and Tobacco Growers Association of North Carolina, Incorporated, may call 23 another referendum in the next succeeding year on the question of the annual 24 assessment for six years. If the tobacco assessment carried in a referendum by 25 two-thirds or more of the eligible farmers participating therein, the assessment shall be 26 levied annually for the six years set forth in the call for the referendum and a new 27 referendum may be called and conducted during the sixth year of the period on the 28 question of whether or not the assessment shall be continued for the next ensuing six 29 vears." 30 SECTION 7. G.S. 106-568.14 reads as rewritten:

31 "§ 106-568.14. Board of directors; membership; compensation.

32 The North Carolina Agricultural Hall of Fame shall be under the general supervision 33 and control of a board of directors consisting of the following: the Commissioner of 34 Agriculture of the State of North Carolina, who shall act as chairman; the Director of 35 the North Carolina Agricultural Extension Service; the State Supervisor of Vocational Agriculture; the President of the North Carolina Farm Bureau Federation; the Master of 36 37 the State Grange, the Executive Director of the North Carolina Agribusiness Council, 38 Inc., the foregoing being ex officio members; and three members who shall be 39 appointed by the Governor of North Carolina. All of said members shall serve without 40 compensation."

18	the North Carolina State Grange, the Executive Director of the North Carolina	
19	Agribusiness Council, Inc., the President of the North Carolina Farm Bureau	
20	Federation, the North Carolina Commissioner of Agriculture, the Dean of the School of	
21	Agriculture and Life Sciences at North Carolina State University, the Dean of the	
22	School of Agriculture at North Carolina Agricultural and Technical State University, the	
23	Chairman of the State Soil and Water Conservation Commission, the President of the	
24	North Carolina Association of Soil and Water Conservation Districts, the Executive
