| 9 | "SECTION 3. Section 1 of this act applies to the City of Albemarle and the Towns |
| 10 | of Beaufort, Highlands, Southern Shores, and Mint Hill only. Section 2 of this act |
| 11 | applies to the Towns of Ansonville, Atlantic Beach, Burgaw, Carolina Beach, |
| 12 | Cramerton, Dallas, Duck, Emerald Isle, Indian Beach, Kill Devil Hills, Kitty Hawk, |
| 13 | Kure Beach, Nags Head, Oakboro, Ocean Isle Beach, North Topsail Beach, Pine Knoll |
| 14 | Shores, Stanley, Surf City, Topsail Beach, and Wrightsville Beach, the Cities of |
| 15 | Albemarle, Belmont, Cherryville, Gastonia, Kings Mountain, Mount Holly, and |
| 16 | Rockingham and the Counties of Cleveland, Currituck, Gaston, Surry, and Wilkes only. |
| 17 | The term 'municipal employee' shall include employees of a county." |
