2 AN ACT TO PROVIDE FUNDS TO ERECT PLAQUES, MARKERS, AND  
3 MONUMENTS TO IDENTIFY KEY PARTICIPANTS AND LOCATIONS  
4 INVOLVED IN THE 1898 WILMINGTON RACE RIOT, TO BE LOCATED IN  
5 WILMINGTON AND STATEWIDE, AS RECOMMENDED BY THE 1898  
6 WILMINGTON RACE RIOT COMMISSION.

7 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

8       **SECTION 1.** There is appropriated from the General Fund jointly to the City  
9 of Wilmington, New Hanover County, and the New Hanover County Branch of the  
10 NAACP the sum of ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) for the 2007-2008 fiscal year to erect  
11 plaques, markers, and monuments to identify key participants and locations involved in  
12 the 1898 Wilmington Race Riot.

13       **SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2007.
