5	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:							
6	SECTION 1. G.S. 15A-1340.17(c) reads as rewritten:							
7	"(c) Punishments for Each Class of Offense and Prior Record Level; Punishment							
8	Chart Described. – The authorized punishment for each class of offense and prior record							
9	level is as specified in the chart below. Prior record levels are indicated by the Roman							
10	numerals placed horizontally on the top of the chart. Classes of offense are indicated by							
11	the letters placed vertically on the left side of the chart. Each cell on the chart contains							
12	the following components:							
13	(1) A sentence disposition or dispositions: "C" indicates that a community							
14	punishment is authorized; "I" indicates that an intermediate							
15	punishment is authorized; "A" indicates that an active punishment is							
16	authorized; and "Life Imprisonment Without Parole" indicates that the							
17	defendant shall be imprisoned for the remainder of the prisoner's							
18	natural life.							
19	(2) A presumptive range of minimum durations, if the sentence of							
20	imprisonment is neither aggravated or mitigated; any minimum term of							
21	imprisonment in that range is permitted unless the court finds pursuant							
22	to G.S. 15A-1340.16 that an aggravated or mitigated sentence is							
23	appropriate. The presumptive range is the middle of the three ranges in							
24	the cell.							
25	(3) A mitigated range of minimum durations if the court finds pursuant to $C = 15 + 1240 + 16$							
26	G.S. 15A-1340.16 that a mitigated sentence of imprisonment is							
27	justified; in such a case, any minimum term of imprisonment in the
