March 22, 2007 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO REOUIRE HEALTH BENEFIT PLANS TO ISSUE INSURANCE IDENTIFICATION CARDS TO POLICYHOLDERS. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: SECTION 1. Article 3 of Chapter 58 of the General Statutes is amended by adding the following new section to read: "§ 58-3-247. Insurance identification card. Every insurer offering a health benefit plan as defined under G.S. 58-3-167 (a) shall provide the health benefit plan policyholder with an insurance identification card. The card shall contain the following clearly identifiable, legible, preprinted information: The policyholder's name and (1)The names and identification numbers of all persons covered a. under the policyholder's health benefit plan, or If an insurance identification card is issued for each person b. included under the subscriber's coverage, the name of the policyholder and the individual or dependent may be listed in lieu of the information required under sub-subdivision a. of this subdivision. The policyholder's identification number and date of birth. (2)The employer group name and, if applicable, employer group number. (3) (4)The effective date of health benefit plan coverage. The name of the policyholder's primary care physician and phone (5) number, if applicable. The name of the policyholder's insurer, the name and logo of the (6) insurer, or the network accessed in North Carolina; the plan or product type (including HMO, POS, PPO, HRA, or HSA) and product names.
