AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO PROVIDE SALARY STIPENDS FOR NONCERTIFIED SCHOOL PERSONNEL WHO ARE ENGAGED IN STUDENT TEACHING.

SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Board of Governors of The University of North Carolina the sum of nine hundred ninety thousand dollars (\$990,000) for the 2007-2008 fiscal year and the sum of nine hundred ninety thousand dollars (\$990,000) for the 2008-2009 fiscal year to provide a salary stipend of three thousand three hundred dollars (\$3,300) to noncertified public school personnel who are enrolled in approved teacher education programs in North Carolina institutions of higher education and are employed in North Carolina public schools while they are engaged in student teaching.

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2007.
