A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO REQUIRE HEALTH BENEFIT PLANS TO ISSUE INSURANCE IDENTIFICATION CARDS TO POLICYHOLDERS. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: SECTION 1. Article 3 of Chapter 58 of the General Statutes is amended by		
adding the following new section to read:		
"§ 58-3-247. Insurance identification card.		
(a) Every insurer offering a health benefit plan as defined under G.S. 58-3-167		
shall provide the health benefit plan policyholder with an insurance identification card.

(12)Insurers shall provide each policyholder with a new insurance identification 12 (b) card whenever any information required to be on the card is changed not later than 30 13 14 days prior to the date the change becomes effective. If the insurer issues annual renewal 15 cards, it may issue a temporary sticker containing the new information in lieu of issuing a new card prior to the annual renewal date. The sticker shall be designed such that it 16 17 can be attached to the existing card. The insurance identification card must be designed 18 such that if the card is photocopied or electronically scanned, the resulting image is 19 clearly legible."

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
