A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

2 AN ACT TO ESTABLISH A NO-WAKE SPEED ZONE NEAR HOLDEN BEACH.

3 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

4 **SECTION 1.** It is unlawful to operate a vessel at greater than a no-wake 5 speed in the Intracoastal Waterway adjacent to the Town of Holden Beach between the 6 Holden Beach Bridge and the inlet at the Lockwood Folly River. No-wake speed is idle 7 speed or a slow speed creating no appreciable wake.

8 **SECTION 2.** With regard to marking the no-wake speed zone established in 9 Section 1 of this act, the Town of Holden Beach, Brunswick County, or their designees 10 may place and maintain the markers in accordance with the Uniform Waterway 11 Marking System and any supplementary standards for such system adopted by the 12 Wildlife Resources Commission. All markers of the no-wake speed zone shall be buoys 13 or floating signs placed in the water and must be sufficient in number and size as to give 14 adequate warning of the no-wake speed zone to the vessels approaching from various 15 directions.

16 **SECTION 3.** This act is enforceable under G.S. 75A-17 as if it were a 17 provision of Chapter 75A of the General Statutes.

SECTION 4. Violation of Section 1 of this act is a Class 3 misdemeanor.

19 **SECTION 5.** This act applies only to the Town of Holden Beach and the 20 surrounding area as described in this act.

21 **SECTION 6.** This act is effective when it becomes law and is enforceable 22 after markers complying with Section 2 of this act are placed in the water.
