Short Title: ABC Election-Cities in Two Counties. (Public)

1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2 AN ACT TO AMEND ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE CONTROL ELECTION LAWS
3 TO ALLOW CITIES WHICH ARE LOCATED IN MORE THAN ONE COUNTY
4 TO HAVE A CITYWIDE ELECTION FOR MIXED BEVERAGES.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 SECTION 1. G.S. 18B-600(e4)(2) reads as rewritten:

7 "§ 18B-600. Places eligible to hold alcoholic beverage elections.

8 ...

9 (e4) Multicounty/City ABC Elections. – If a city is located in two or more
10 counties, the following provisions shall apply:

11 ...

12 (2) The city may hold a mixed beverage election if the city has at least 500
13 registered voters and a county in which a portion of the city is located
14 operates ~~ABC stores-stores~~, or a municipality in either county in which
15 the city is located operates an ABC store.

17 SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2007.
