AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR TWO ADDITIONAL ASSISTANT
DISTRICT ATTORNEYS AND TWO ADDITIONAL VICTIM WITNESS LEGAL
ASSISTANTS FOR THE 19A PROSECUTORIAL DISTRICT.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. G.S. 7A-60(a1) reads as rewritten:

"(a1) The counties of the State are organized into prosecutorial districts, and each district has the counties and the number of full-time assistant district attorneys set forth in the following table:

41 **SECTION 2.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Judicial
 42 Department the sum of two hundred ninety-nine thousand four hundred sixty-two
 43 dollars (\$299,462) for the 2007-2008 fiscal year and the sum of two hundred
 44 eighty-seven thousand nine hundred ten dollars (\$287,910) for the 2008-2009 fiscal year

- 1 to fund the two additional assistant district attorneys authorized for Prosecutorial
2 District 19A by this act and two victim witness legal assistants for District 19A.
3 **SECTION 3.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2007.
