2 Speaker of the House of Representatives.

3 (12) One person associated with the tourism-related transportation industry,
4 appointed by the President Pro Tempore of the Senate. One person
5 who is not a member of the General Assembly, appointed by the
6 President Pro Tempore of the Senate.

7 (13) Four public members each interested in matters relating to travel and
8 tourism, two appointed by the Governor (one from a rural area and one
9 from an urban area), one appointed by the Speaker of the House, and
10 one appointed by the President Pro Tempore of the Senate.

11 (14) One member associated with the major cultural resources and activities
12 of the State in North Carolina, appointed by the Governor.

13 (15) Two members of the House of Representatives, appointed by the
14 Speaker of the House of Representatives.

15 (16) Two members of the Senate, appointed by the President Pro Tempore
16 of the Senate.

17 (17) Two members designated by the Board of Directors of North Carolina
18 Watermen United who represent the charter boat industry."

19 **SECTION 2.** G.S. 143B-434.1(f) reads as rewritten:

20 "(f) Appointments to fill vacancies in the membership of the Board that occur due
21 to resignation, dismissal, death, addition of, or disability of a member shall be for the
22 balance of the unexpired term and shall be made by the same appointing authority that
23 made the initial appointment."

24 **SECTION 3.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
