10	SECT	FION 1. G.S. 95-241(a) reads as rewritten:

14	(1)	File a claim or complaint, initiate any inquiry, investigation,
15		inspection, proceeding or other action, or testify or provide
16		information to any person with respect to any of the following:
17		a. Chapter 97 of the General Statutes.
18		b. Article 2A or Article 16 of this Chapter.
19		c. Article 2A of Chapter 74 of the General Statutes.
20		d. G.S. 95-28.1.
21		e. Article 16 of Chapter 127A of the General Statutes.
22		f. G.S. 95-28.1A.
23		g. <u>Article 52 of Chapter 143 of the General Statutes.</u>
24	(2)	Cause any of the activities listed in subdivision (1) of this subsection
25		to be initiated on an employee's behalf.
26	(3)	Exercise any right on behalf of the employee or any other employee
27		afforded by Article 2A or Article 16 of this Chapter or Chapter, by

1	Article 2A of Chapter 74 of the General Statutes. Statutes, or by Article
2	52 of Chapter 143 of the General Statutes.
3	(4) Comply with the provisions of Article 27 of Chapter 7B of the General
4	Statutes.
5	(5) Exercise rights under Chapter 50B. Actions brought under this
6	subdivision shall be in accordance with the provisions of
7	G.S. 50B-5.5."
8	SECTION 2. The Pesticide Board shall adopt rules to implement the
9	recommendations of the Governor's Task Force on Preventing Agricultural Pesticide
10	Exposure, requiring recording of the specific time of day when each pesticide
11	application was completed and extending the retention period for pesticide application
12	records for all pesticides covered under the Worker Protection Standards for
13	Agricultural Pesticides from 30 days to two years.
14	SECTION 3. This act is effective when it becomes law.
