The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. G.S. 7A-133(a) reads as rewritten:

"(a) Each district court district shall have the numbers of judges as set forth in the following table:

SECTION 2. The Governor shall appoint the additional district court judge
for District 19A authorized by this act, and that judge's successor shall be elected in the
2008 election for a four-year term commencing January 1, 2009.
SECTION 3. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Judicial
Department the sum of eighty thousand eight hundred twenty dollars (\$80,820) for the

Department the sum of eighty thousand eight hundred twenty dollars (\$80,820) for the 2007-2008 fiscal year and the sum of one hundred thirty-six thousand six hundred sixty dollars (\$136,660) for the 2008-2009 fiscal year to fund the additional district court judgeship authorized by this act.

SECTION 4. This act becomes effective January 1, 2008.
