BILL SUMMARY: Amends G.S. 20-16(c) to specify that there will be no insurance surcharge points assessed to the driver for a violation reported to the North Carolina Division of Motor Vehicles from another state in which there are no points assessed for that particular violation or equivalent offense in North Carolina.
