BILL SUMMARY:

The Proposed Committee Substitute for Senate Bill 1036 would:

- Authorize DMV to develop specialized license plates for motorcycles. Under this bill, DMV would be authorized to develop for a motorcycle any special registration plate that is currently authorized for other motor vehicles. If a special registration plate is subject to a minimum 300-application requirement, then there would also have to be a minimum of 300 applications for that plate to be developed as a motorcycle plate.
- Authorize DMV to issue two new special registration plates: one for the Back Country Horsemen of NC and one for the Maggie Valley Trout Festival.

ASSUMPTIONS AND METHODOLOGY:

Senate Bill 1036 authorizes two special plates subject to the \$10 fee and therefore is anticipated to have a fiscal impact. Fiscal Research Division does not have any means to

determine how many individuals will sign up for either of these plates and therefore cannot provide a monetary estimate.
