1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2 AN ACT TO ALLOW AUTOMATIC DIALING AND RECORDED MESSAGE PLAYERS
3 TO BE USED TO MAKE UNSOLICITED TELEPHONE CALLS TO PROTECT THE
4 PUBLIC HEALTH, SAFETY, OR WELFARE.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 **SECTION 1.** G.S. 75-104(b) is amended by adding a new subdivision to read:

7 "(7) The purpose of the unsolicited telephone call is to protect the public health,
8 safety, or welfare, by informing the telephone subscriber of any of the
9 following:

- 10 a. That the telephone subscriber has purchased a product that may be
11 subject to a recall due to safety concerns.
12 b. That the telephone subscriber may have received a prescription or
13 over-the-counter medication that is subject to a recall due to safety
14 concerns.
15 c. That the telephone subscriber has not picked up a filled prescription
16 drug for which a valid prescription is on file with a pharmacy
17 licensed pursuant to G.S. 90-85.21.
18 d. That an account maintained by the telephone subscriber may be
19 subject to potential fraudulent activity."

20 **SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
