A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO APPLY CLIENT RIGHTS AND HUMAN RIGHTS COMMITTEE REQUIREMENTS FOR MENTAL HEALTH, DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES, AND SUBSTANCE ABUSE SERVICES FACILITIES, AND LOCAL MANAGEMENT ENTITIES, TO PROVIDER ENTITIES. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: SECTION 1. G.S. 122C-64 reads as rewritten:		
"§ 122C-64. <u>Client rights and</u> Human rights committees.		
Human rights committees responsible for protecting the rights of clients shall be established		
at each State facility and for each area authority and county program.facility, for each local		
management entity, and provider entities. The Commission shall adopt rules for the		

12 establishment, composition, and duties of the committees and procedures for appointment and 13 coordination with the State and Local Consumer Advocacy programs. In multicounty area 14 authorities and multicounty programs, the membership of the <u>client rights and</u> human rights

15 committee shall include a representative from each of the participating counties."

**SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
