5	SECTION 1. G.S. 62-3(1) reads as rewritten:	
6	"(1) "Broadband service" means any service that consists of or includes a
7		high-speed access capability to transmit at a rate of not less than 200 kilobits
8		per second in either the upstream or downstream direction and either (i) is
9		used to provide access to the Internet, or (ii) provides computer processing,
10		information storage, information content, or protocol conversion, including
11		any service applications or information service provided over such
12		high-speed access service. "Broadband service" includes any service that
13		enables the end user to send or receive communications in Internet protocol
14		or a successor protocol. "Broadband service" does not include intrastate
15		service that was tariffed by the Commission and in effect as of the effective
16		date of this subdivision."
17	SI	ECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
