### A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

#### 2 AN ACT AMENDING THE DEFINITION OF BROADBAND SERVICE TO ENCOURAGE 3 DEPLOYMENT OF COMPETITIVE INTERNET PROTOCOL-ENABLED SERVICES.

4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

5 **SECTION 1.** G.S. 62-2(b1) reads as rewritten: 6 "(b1) Broadband service provided by public utilities as defined in G.S. 62-3(23)a.6. is 7 sufficiently competitive and shall not be regulated by the Commission. Nothing herein shall be 8 construed to modify the authority of any entity to enforce applicable State or federal statutes or 9 regulations relating to switched access rates or other intercarrier compensation rates for interexchange services provided by a local exchange telecommunications company, or to 10 modify any authority of the State or a political subdivision of the State with respect to cable 11 services consistent with Article 42 of Chapter 66 of the General Statutes and Title VI of the 12 Communications Act of 1934, 47 U.S.C. § 521, et seq." 13

17	per second in either the upstream or downstream direction and either (i) is
18	used to provide access to the Internet, or (ii) provides computer processing,
19	information storage, information content, or protocol conversion, including
20	any service applications or information service provided over such
21	high-speed access service. "Broadband service" includes any service that
22	enables the end user to send or receive communications in Internet protocol
23	or a successor protocol, including, but not limited to, voice-over-Internet
24	protocol. "Broadband service" does not include intrastate service that was
25	tariffed by the Commission and in effect as of the effective date of this
26	subdivision."
