Short Title: Larceny of a Motor Vehicle Part. (Public) Sponsors: Referred to: April 9, 2009 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO CREATE THE CRIMINAL OFFENSE OF LARCENY OF A MOTOR VEHICLE PART. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: **SECTION 1.** Article 16 of Chapter 14 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new section to read: "§ 14-72.8. Larceny of motor vehicle parts. Unless the conduct is covered under some other provision of law providing greater punishment, larceny of a motor vehicle part valued at one thousand dollars (\$1,000) or less may be punished as follows: For a first offense under this subsection, a person is guilty of a Class 1 (1) misdemeanor. For a second or subsequent offense under this subsection, a person is guilty (2) of a Class I felony. Unless the conduct is covered under some other provision of law providing greater punishment, larceny of a motor vehicle part valued at more than one thousand dollars (\$1,000) may be punished as follows: For a first offense under this subsection, a person is guilty of a Class H (1) For a second or subsequent offense under this subsection, a person is guilty (2) of a Class G felony." SECTION 2. This act becomes effective December 1, 2009, and applies to
