8	There sh	all be an additional fine of one hundred dollars (\$100.00) added to any fine
9	assessed by the court for a conviction of a charge resulting from a moving motor vehicle	
10	violation where mobile phone use is noted as a distraction."	
11	SECTION 2. This act becomes effective December 1, 2009, and applies to	
12	offenses committed on or after that date.
