"(a) D empowered,	ECTION 1. G.S. 143-215.107(a) reads as rewritten: uty to Adopt Plans, Standards, etc. – The Commission is hereby directed and as rapidly as possible within the limits of funds and facilities available to it, and procedural requirements of this Article and Article 21:
(5	To develop and adopt emission control standards as in the judgment of the Commission may be necessary to prohibit, abate, or control air pollution commensurate with established air quality standards. This subdivision does not apply to that portion of the National Emission Standards for Hazardous Air Pollutants for asbestos that governs demolition and renovation as set ou in 40 C.F.R. § 61.141, 61.145, 61.150, and 61.154 (1 July 1993 edition).any air emission source subject to hazardous air pollutant emission standards under 40 C.F.R. Pts. 61 and 63.

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2009.
