AN ACT TO CLARIFY DOMESTIC VIOLENCE LAWS REGARDING WHEN A LAW
ENFORCEMENT OFFICER MUST ARREST A PERSON WHO HAS KNOWINGLY
VIOLATED A VALID PROTECTIVE ORDER.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. G.S. 50B-4.1(b) reads as rewritten:

7 "(b) A law enforcement officer <u>shall must</u> arrest and take a person into custody without a 8 warrant or other process if the officer has where there is probable cause to believe that the 9 person knowingly has violated a valid protective order excluding the person from the residence 10 or household occupied by a victim of domestic violence or directing the person to refrain from 11 doing any or all of the acts specified in G.S. 50B-3(a)(9)."

12 **SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
