A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT REQUIRING "CREDIT EDUCATION" FOR ALL STUDENTS.

3 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. G.S. 115C-81(i) reads as rewritten:

5 "(i) Both the standard course of study and the Basic Education Program shall include the 6 requirement that the public schools provide instruction in personal financial literacy for all 7 students during the high school years.students. Each student shall receive personal financial 8 literacy instruction that shall include (i) the true cost of credit, (ii) choosing and managing a 9 credit card, (iii) borrowing money for an automobile or other large purchase, (iv) home 10 mortgages, (v) credit scoring and credit reports, and (vi) other relevant financial literacy issues. 11 The State Board of Education shall determine the other components of personal financial

11 The State Board of Education shall determine the <u>other</u> components of personal financial 12 literacy that will be covered in the curriculum. The State Board shall also determine in which 13 <u>course into which courses and grade levels</u> the new personal financial literacy curriculum can 14 <u>shall</u> be integrated."

15 SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law and applies beginning with
16 the 2011-2012 school year.



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
