6	SECTION 1. Article 16 of Chapter 131E of the General Statutes is amended by		у

8	" <u>§ 131E-272. Initial licensure fees for new facilities.</u>		
9	The Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Health Service Regulation,		
10	shall impose an initial licensure fee of five hundred seventy-five dollars (\$575.00) for new		
11	home care agencies to provide in-home aide services."		
12		ECTION 2. Beginning October 1, 2009, and for a period of one year thereafter	
13	the Department of Health and Human Services shall not issue any licenses for new home care		
14	agencies that intend to offer in-home aide services. This prohibition shall not restrict the		
15	Department from issuing licenses to certified home health agencies that intend to offer in-home		
16	aide services or to agencies that need a new license for an existing home care agency being		
17	acquired. The purpose of this section is to allow the Department of Health and Human		
18	Services more time to work with existing home care agencies to assure compliance with newly		У
19	adopted home		
20		ECTION 3. Section 1 of this act becomes effective July 1, 2009. The remainde	r
21	of this act is e	effective when it becomes law.
