2 AN ACT TO REQUIRE THE INCLUSION OF PERSONAL FINANCE AND 3 PARENTHOOD TRAINING IN NORTH CAROLINA'S MIDDLE-SCHOOL 4 CURRICULUM, AS RECOMMENDED BY THE JOINT LEGISLATIVE STUDY 5 COMMISSION ON POVERTY REDUCTION AND ECONOMIC RECOVERY. 6 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: 7 **SECTION 1.** G.S. 115C-81(e1)(1) reads as rewritten: A comprehensive school health education program shall be developed and 8 "(1) taught to pupils of the public schools of this State from kindergarten through 9 ninth grade. This program includes age-appropriate instruction in the 10 following subject areas, regardless of whether this instruction is described 11 as, or incorporated into a description of, "family life education", "family 12 health education", "health education", "family living", "health", "healthful 13 14 living curriculum", or "self-esteem": Mental and emotional health; 15 a. 16 Drug and alcohol abuse prevention; b. Nutrition: 17 c. 18 d. Dental health: 19 Environmental health; e. 20 f. Family living; living, which in the middle schools shall include training for parenthood, both fathers and mothers; 21 Consumer health; health; which in the middle schools shall include 22 g. training in personal finance. 23 24 Disease control; h. 25 Growth and development; i. First aid and emergency care, including the teaching of 26 j. cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) and the Heimlich maneuver by 27 using hands-on training with mannequins so that students become 28 proficient in order to pass a test approved by the American Heart 29 Association, or American Red Cross; 30 Preventing sexually transmitted diseases, including HIV/AIDS, and 31 k. 32 other communicable diseases; 33 1. Reproductive health and safety education; and Bicycle safety. 34 m.
